WHAT IS VidZone™?

VidZone™ is the exciting music video service that provides you with access to thousands of music videos. VidZone™ is available to download for FREE from PlayStation®Network and this manual contains all the information you need to enjoy its exciting features. More information on PlayStation®Network can be found on eu.playstation.com.

There are hours of fun to be had in VidZone™. You can browse the catalogue at your leisure, and then pick and choose the music videos you want to watch. Play, pause, rewind and fast forward, and create your own personalised, custom playlists, perfect for your next party or for easy access to your favourite artist's hits.






All videos are streamed and you can also download music videos, ringtones and music tracks to your mobile phone for a charge, subject to compatibility and availability, via the VidZone™ Wap Site.

The VidZone™ service is offered to you by VidZone™, a division of Rants Limited.


HOW TO INSTALL VidZone™

Set up the PLAYSTATION®3 system according to the instructions in its Quick Reference manual. At start-up, the power indicator will glow red to indicate that the PLAYSTATION®3 system is in Standby Mode. Press the power button and the power indicator will turn green. Before installing VidZone™, you will need to create a PlayStation®Network account. See the "VidZone™ AND PlayStation®Network" section outlined later in this manual.

To install VidZone™:

- Select the  (PlayStation®Network) icon from the XMB Screen
- Select the  (PlayStation®Store) icon
- Select the "Other Media" category
- Select the "Applications and Services" category
- Highlight "VidZone™" and press the  button to continue
- Select "Download" and press the  button to confirm
- VidZone™ will be displayed in your download list. Highlight VidZone™ and press the  button to start downloading
- VidZone™ will download and install onto your PLAYSTATION®3 system. 50MB of free space on the Hard Disk Drive (HDD) is needed for successful installation




- Press the PS button and select "Yes" to exit PlayStation®Store and return to the XMB Screen
- Select the  icon from the XMB Screen
- Select the VidZone™ icon to launch the application
- Finally, enter your PlayStation®Network sign-in ID and password and get ready to enjoy VidZone™

PLEASE NOTE: Do not insert or remove accessories once the power is turned on. Please refer to the PLAYSTATION®3 system's Quick Reference manual for further details about setting up and recharging a wireless controller. Make sure there is enough free space on the HDD before commencing installation.

The information in this manual was correct at the time of publication, but some minor changes may have been made late in the product's development. All screenshots for this manual have been taken from the English version of this product.

VidZone™ AND PlayStation®Network*

CREATING NEW USERS

If using the PLAYSTATION®3 system for the first time, a new user name must be created. Select the "Users" category from the Menu Screen and choose "Create New User". Enter a new user name via the virtual keyboard. If multiple user names exist, the Log In screen will be displayed upon start-up. Select the desired user icon and press the  button to log in.

When signing up to PlayStation®Network, a password, a secret answer to a security question and a valid email address must be supplied. An Online ID must also be chosen and will act as your publicly displayed name within PlayStation®Network. After an Online ID has been created it cannot be changed.

Once you have set up your PlayStation®Network account, you can then visit PlayStation®Store to download VidZone™ for free!

GETTING STARTED

- Make sure the PLAYSTATION®3 system is turned on and the VidZone™ application is installed on the HDD
- Select the icon from the XMB Screen
- Select the VidZone™ icon to launch the application. You will be prompted for your PlayStation®Network sign-in ID and password
- VidZone™ will commence loading. A message will be displayed to confirm that the music video catalogue is updating content
- The User Interface Language Screen will be displayed. Press or to choose a language from English, French, Italian, German, Spanish, Dutch or Portuguese and press the button to confirm your selection
- The Content Language Screen may be displayed. Press or to choose a language from English, French, Italian, German or Spanish and press the button to confirm your selection
- Finally, you will arrive at the Home Page and the fun can begin

HOME PAGE

The Home Page displays the latest VidZone™ content, including new releases and exclusive playlists. You can return to the **Home Page** at any time by selecting **Home Page** on the **Featured** Menu Screen.

USING MENU SCREENS

Press the , , or directional buttons to highlight an option, then press the button to confirm. To return to the previous menu screen, press the button.

THE MENUS SCREEN

The options on the **Menus** Screen are as follows: **Featured**, **Search**, **Playlists**, **Now Playing**, **Download**, **Related Videos** and **Settings**.

FEATURED

View the latest music video releases and chart hits. Press the ⊗ button to select **Chart** or **Latest Releases** and then highlight the music video you want to watch from the catalogue. To return to the **Home Page**, highlight **Home Page** and press the ⊗ button to confirm.

For more play and download options, please refer to the “**Video Options**” section outlined later in this manual.

SEARCH

Search for music videos in VidZone™ by video name, artist name or music genre. Press the ⊗ button to select a preference and then press ↑, ↓, ← or → to enter the name of the music video or the artist. Press the ⊗ button to confirm the name.

For more play and download options, please refer to the “**Video Options**” section outlined later in this manual.

PLAYLISTS

Create and personalise playlists or choose playlists recommended by VidZone™.

To create a new playlist:

- Choose Playlists from the Menus Screen and press the ⊗ button to confirm
- Highlight My Playlists on the Playlists Menu and press the ⊗ button to confirm
- Select New Playlist and then give it a name and a brief description, using the virtual keyboard
- Finally, highlight Save Playlist and press the ⊗ button to confirm

Highlight a playlist and press the ⊕ button to access additional options. Play the music videos instantly by selecting **Play Now** or add the playlist to the **Now Playing** queue. You can also delete playlists and edit their names.

VidZone™ features its own playlists full of top music videos. Highlight **Recommended** on the **Playlists** Menu and press the ⊗ button to confirm.

For more information on how to add tracks to your playlist, please see **Add to Playlist** in the “**Video Options**” section outlined later in this manual.

NOW PLAYING

Add unlimited music videos to a catalogue and watch them in sequence. Highlight **Now Playing** on the **Menus** Screen and press the ⊕ button for options. Select **Shuffle** to randomly mix up the playing order or select **Loop On** to enjoy your **Now Playing** catalogue over and over again. Alternatively, you can delete your **Now Playing** catalogue or save it as a playlist.

Highlight **Now Playing** and press the ⊗ button to access the **Now Playing** catalogue. Highlight a music video and press the ⊖ button to play the music video instantly. To access more options, highlight a music video and press the ⊕ button. To play the music video, highlight **Play Now** and press the ⊗ button to confirm. You can also delete the music video, move it to a different position in the catalogue, add it to a playlist or **download** it to your mobile phone for a charge, subject to compatibility and availability, via the VidZone™ Wap Site.

DOWNLOAD

Take your music with you on the go. For information on downloading music videos, ringtones and music tracks to your mobile phone, please see **Download** in the “**Video Options**” section outlined later in this manual.

RELATED VIDEOS

Select extra music videos to complement those already in your **Playlists** and **Now Playing** catalogue.

PLEASE NOTE: The Related Videos folder will remain empty until a music video is played. Once a music video has been played, a list of related songs will appear when the folder is reopened.

PlayStation®Store

Extra content, including PLAYSTATION®3 games may be downloaded from PlayStation®Store, accessible through the **Download** Menu or on-screen adverts. You can continue to use VidZone™ after leaving PlayStation®Store.

VIDEO OPTIONS

There's plenty of fun to be had in VidZone™. Highlight a music video from the catalogues available and press the ⊗ button to confirm your selection. Press the △ button to access the following options: **Play Now**, **Add To Now Playing**, **Add To Playlist** and **Download**.

NOTE: Some music videos may not support all video options.

PLAY NOW

Locate your favourite music video and watch it instantly. Highlight Play Now and press the ⊗ button to confirm. Alternatively, highlight a music video from the catalogues available and press the ⊞ button to play the music video.

ADD TO NOW PLAYING

Select **Add To Now Playing** and your music video will join the end of the **Now Playing** queue. You can also select music videos to add to **Now Playing** by highlighting a music video in the lists available and pressing the ⊗ button to confirm the selection.

ADD TO PLAYLIST

To add a music video to a playlist, select **Add to Playlist**, choose an existing playlist and press the ⊗ button to confirm. Your selected music video will copy to the playlist.

DOWNLOAD

Download music videos, ringtones and music tracks to your mobile phone.

To download music:

- Select Download and press the ⊗ button to confirm
- Highlight Download For Mobile and press the ⊗ button to confirm
- You will be notified that there is a charge to download music. Highlight OK and press the ⊗ button to confirm
- Select your country of residence from the list and enter your mobile number using the virtual keyboard

- You can now download ringtones, music videos and music tracks. VidZone™ will send a text message to your phone containing a link to the VidZone™ Wap Site where you can view download prices and confirm your purchase. You will be billed via your mobile operator**

PLEASE NOTE: To download music to your mobile phone, you will need to accept the conditions outlined in the Privacy Policy and the conditions outlined in the VidZone™ Wap Site. Press the ⊗ button to select the Privacy Policy and press the TRIANGLE button to accept it.

SETTINGS

SOUND EFFECTS VOLUME

Control the volume of the sound effects whilst navigating the menus and options available.

EDITORIAL LANGUAGE

Music feature articles and VidZone™ announcements can be viewed in numerous languages. Press ↑ or ↓ to highlight **English, Français, Español, Italiano** or **Deutsch** and press the ⊗ button to confirm.

LANGUAGE

On-screen text can be viewed in numerous languages. Press ↑ or ↓ to highlight **English, Français, Español, Italiano** or **Deutsch** and press the ⊗ button to confirm.

TIDY UP LIBRARY

Occasionally VidZone™ will remove music videos from its catalogue to make room for exciting new content. Tidy Up Library is the convenient way to remove deleted music videos from your playlists. Highlight yes or no to use or reject this service and press the ⊗ button to confirm. Any content you may have downloaded will be unaffected.

The first time you enter VidZone™ you will need to read and accept the VidZone™ Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy. Select **Terms and Conditions** to refer back to them at any time.
